On the 3rd of August 1854, the Examiner recorded that three sailors from the barque "Elizabeth Radcliffe" which had been docked in George Town had refused to rejoin the ship for its voyage home. One of the three sailors was **William Holyman**. After being escorted back to the ship and then swimming to shore again, Holyman aligned a course that would create an Australian shipping dynasty.
